The next introductory session for the Creighton Model FertilityCare System will be Tuesday, January 13, at 6 pm in the Social Hall. The Creighton Model can be used by couples as a method of Natural Family Planning to avoid pregnancy (99.5% effective) or to achieve pregnancy (3X more effective than IVF in couples of infertility).
